Abstract Submissions

The one page abstract should contain sufficient information for the committee to be able to make a valid decision as to the intrinsic merit of the paper and its relevance to the aims of the conference. Authors should indicate on the reply form whether they prefer oral or poster presentation. Proposals are also invited for panel discussions and special workshops — these special sessions may be scheduled during the daytime conference timetable or alternatively can be allocated as either breakfast or evening sessions.

Abstracts of all papers to be presented (oral and poster) will be included on a USB device which will be distributed to delegates on registration.
